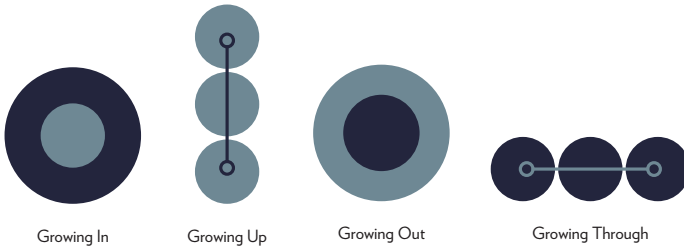

### *PARKING*

Limited visitor parking on the northern side of St Philip's can be accessed from Clarence Street. Free parking is available on Sundays in the underground car park at No. 1 York Street for swipe card holders. Entry via Clarence Street, from 7:30am to 10:00pm each Sunday. ### *PEDESTRIAN ACCESS TO PARKING AT 1 YORK STREET*

For your safety please enter and exit the carpark via the lobby and lifts, or fire stairs.

### *YOUR COMFORT*

Our toilets are located in the Parish Hall (St Philip's) and from the Car Park (Garrison)
